Art. 5 (10b) DGA:

"When justified by a substantial number of requests across the Union concerning the reuse of nonpersonal data in specific third countries, the Commission may adopt implementing acts declaring that the legal, supervisory and enforcement arrangements of a third country:

- (a) ensure protection of intellectual property and trade secrets in a way that is essentially equivalent to the protection ensured under Union law;
- (b) are being effectively applied and enforced; and
- (c) provide effective judicial redress.

Those implementing acts shall be adopted in accordance with the examination procedure referred to in Article 29 (2a)."
